OUR PROGRESS

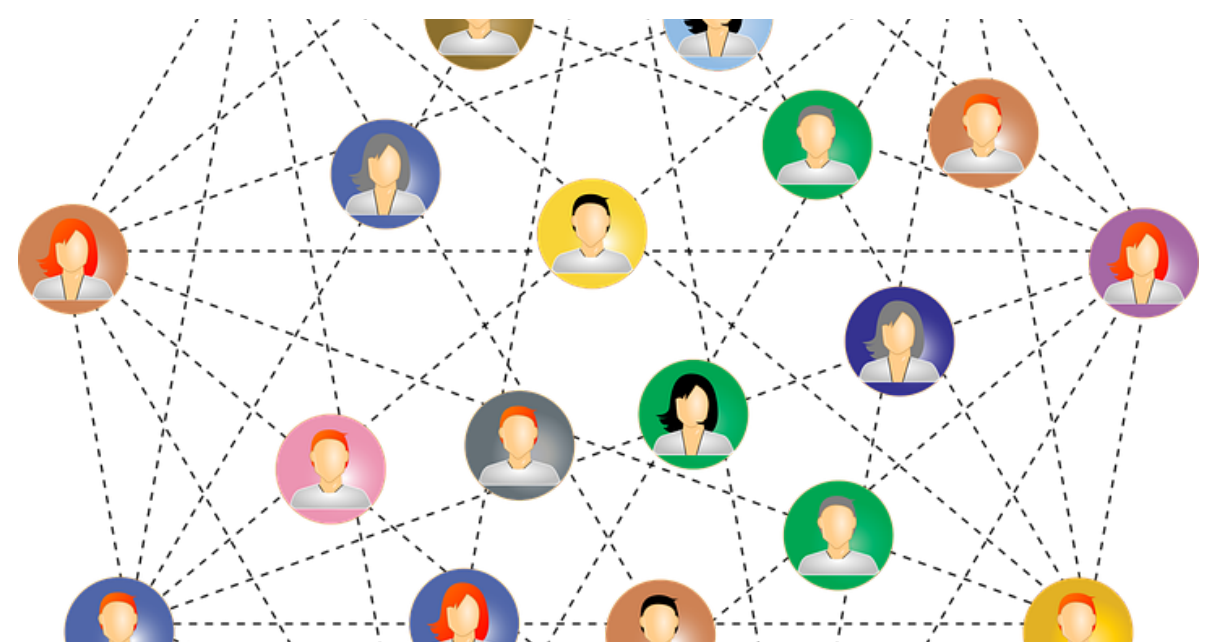
